English

Maths

Number bonds to 10 and 20 including subtraction sums, e.g. $20 - 2 = 18$ and $2 + 18 = 20$ and they have asked you at least 5 questions.

Practise saying the Spanish phrases, "Hello, Mr/Mrs., what is your name? How old are you?".
