## This Time in History

**July 1, 1863** - Beginning of the Battle of Gettysburg during the American Civil War.

**July 6, 1885** - Louis Pasteur gave the first successful anti-rabies inoculation to a boy who had been bitten by an infected dog.

**July 10, 1973** - The Bahamas gained their independence after 250 years as a British Crown Colony.

**July 16, 1969** - The Apollo 11 Lunar landing mission began with a lift off from Kennedy Space Center at 9:37 a.m.

**July 21, 1898** - Guam was ceded to the United States by Spain.

**July 28, 1943** - During World War II, a firestorm killed 42,000 civilians in Hamburg, Germany. The firestorm occurred after 2,326 tons of bombs and incendiaries were dropped by the Allies.

## **School Meals**



Reminder children in year 2 will no longer qualify for Universal Infant Free Meals when they return as year 3 in September. The Current meal price is £10 per week payable on a Monday in advance on Parent Pay (this will almost certainly rise to £10.50 per week, £2.10 per day).

Current nursery children will qualify for Universal Infant Free Meals when they return as Reception children in September. However, you will need to inform the school office if you wish your child to take the free meal. If you qualify for benefit related free meals, you will still need to apply/renew your claim if it expires to enable your child to continue having free milk.

If you have children starting in September and qualify for free meals, you will need to add your child to your claim. The number is 0161 7932500
