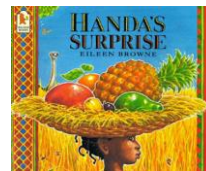


Nursery – People Who Help Us

The next topic for the children in the Nursery is 'People who help us.' We intend for the children to understand the roles that people play in their community and how they help the children in their everyday life. The roles we will cover will be Police officers, Firefighters, Doctors/Nurses, Paramedics, Dentists, Vets, Postmen, refuse collectors, and shop workers/delivery drivers. The children will have lots of opportunities to learn about this topic through non-fiction books, and with adults supporting internet research.

Reception – Around the world

The Reception children's topic for the second part of the Spring term is 'All around the world.' The focus is for the children to learn more about our world, what different parts of the world are called and where they are located, and learn all about different cultures through the texts that will be covered.



We hope that the children will love learning about hot and cold climates, the different ways people dress, and sampling different types of food too.
